Helping people with cancer that don't have the financial means or a family network to support them doesn't always make for a good news story – but luckily this is one of those joyous occasions where we have some great news.

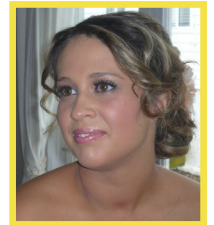
Remission for 8 to 10 years!

I'm happy to report that after five rounds of chemotherapy all is going fantastic - the chemo is working better than the doctor had anticipated and it looks like after my final round of chemo in December I'll be in remission for hopefully 8-10 years! I have been fortunate to have tolerated the chemo extremely well, I didn't lose my hair and have managed to lead a normal life and feel well (most of the time) - an infection saw me hospitalised for a few days, but apart from that I'm grateful that the most I've suffered has been from extreme tiredness. It's been a rollercoaster ride emotionally of highs and lows, but now I'm feeling better, happier and looking forward to 2011 and beyond and being cancer free. Thank you to everybody who has supported me and sent me well wishes and to Reg, for just being there (even when I wasn't up for chatting). I am proud to call myself a cancer survivor!"*
